



Staff to Senior Staff Engineer/Geologist/Scientist – Emeryville

We are seeking a Staff to Senior Staff Engineer with up to 5 years of work experience to perform field and office duties on diverse environmental projects, including site investigation, hazardous waste remediation, surface water quality, and environmental compliance.

The position will be based in our Emeryville office but offers flexibility to work from our Mountain View office periodically or on a more frequent basis.

Essential duties may include, but will not be limited to:

- Performing field work on an as-needed basis including, but not limited to, collecting field measurements and samples; documenting field observations and activities; directing/monitoring contractors performing drilling and earthwork; and performing routine maintenance on remote data collection and remediation equipment.
- Planning, coordinating and writing reports that document field methods, and data and calculations related to groundwater flow and treatment and storm water hydrology;
- Reviewing field data and notes, performing quality control procedures for field work, and interpreting results to ensure regulatory/permit compliance and evaluate progress;
- Coordinating, scheduling and directing field activities for other technical staff; and,
- Other duties as assigned.

Requirements include a BS degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering, Geology, or similar technical degree; MS degree preferred.

Must be willing and able to perform field work in all weather conditions and wear a respirator as required.

This position requires a strong working knowledge of Microsoft Office 365 Suite.; CAD and ArcView GIS knowledge are beneficial.

A valid California driver's license is required. The successful candidate must present a DMV record upon request; driving record must be acceptable under Weiss Associates' insurance carrier's requirements.
